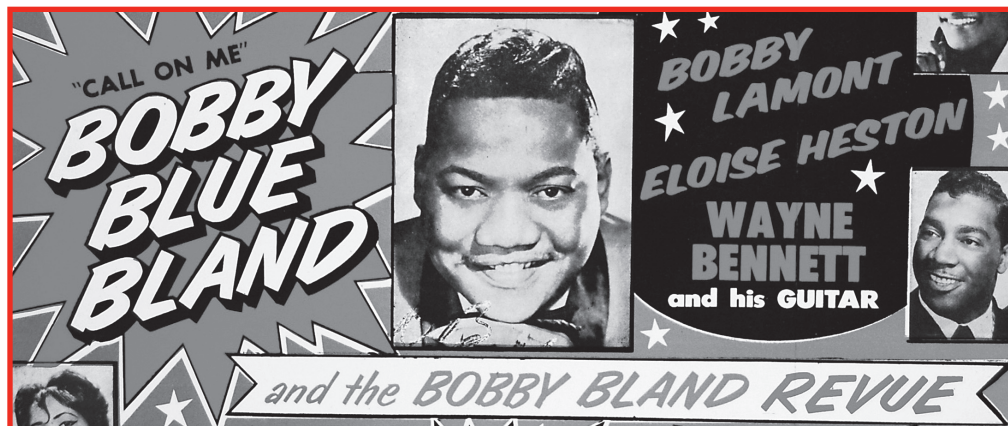

Born: January 27, 1930 – Died: June 23, 2013

Grammy Lifetime Achievement Award Winner and Blues Hall of Fame and Rock and Roll Hall of Fame member Bobby Blue Bland began his musical career singing on the porch at the J. H. Barret & Son General Store for 25¢ and 50¢ pieces in the early 1940's. The above is a portion of a promotional poster from 1957. His career spanned more than 60 years and included such songs as "Cry, Cry, Cry", "I Pity the Fool", and "Further Up The Road."

  - **Jack Frost** providing frosties and homemade ice cream

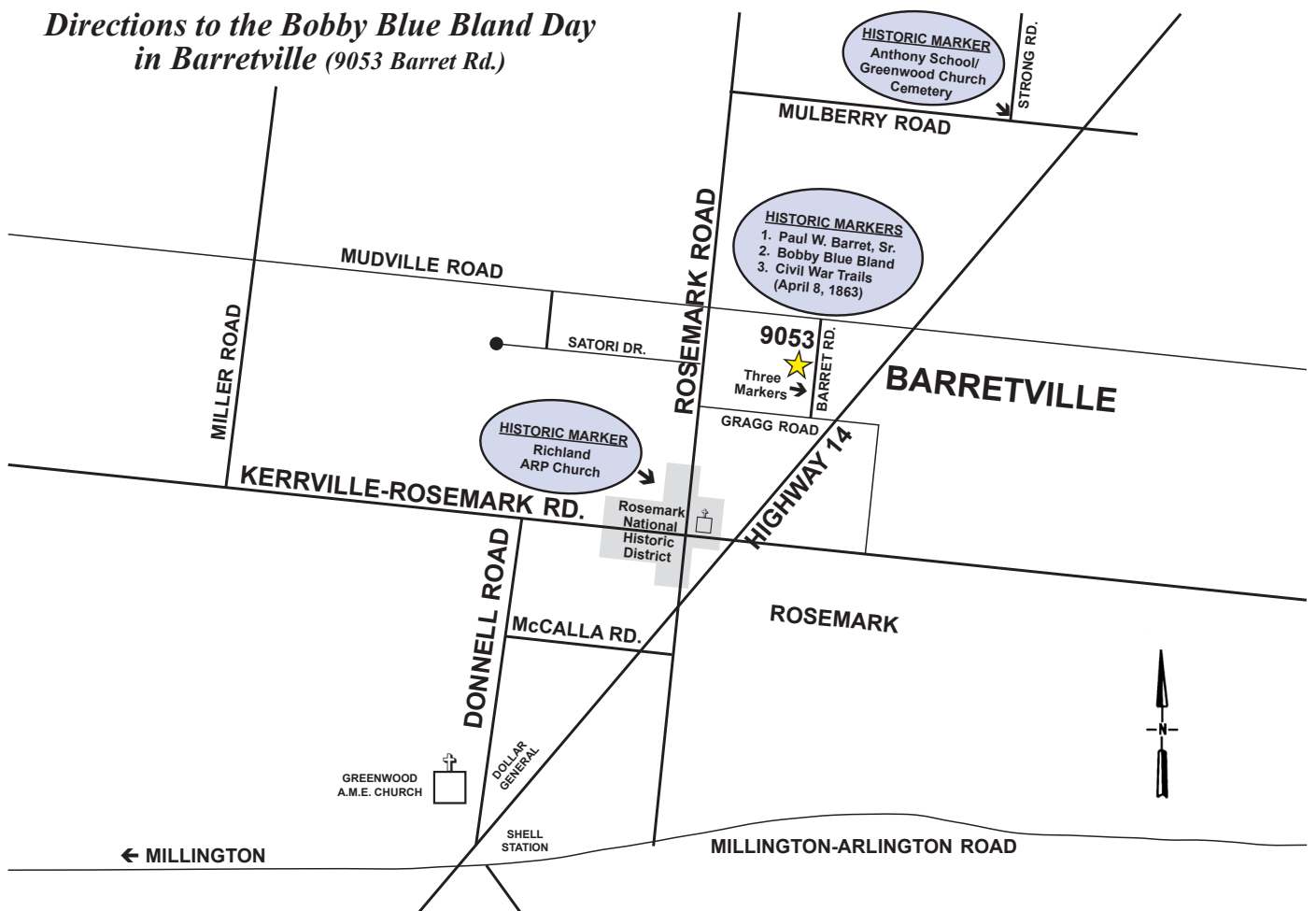

Follow State Highway 14 (Austin Peay) north through the blinking light at Millington-Arlington Road. Proceed past the intersection with Kerrville-Rosemark Road and past the intersection with Gragg Road (do not turn on Gragg Road) to the intersection with Mudville Road. Turn left (west) on Mudville Road and proceed to the intersection with Barret Road. Turn left on Barret Road and proceed ¼ mile. You have arrived at the historic J. H. Barret & Son General Store building and the home of Long Road Cider. There is parking on the east side of Barret Road and limited parking at Patriot Bank.
